FPS Limits & Rules 2022

Electric, HPA & Gas Powered Fully Automatic Weapons

Max 360 fps or 1.2 joules. Max permitted BB weight 0.32g.

No Minimum Engagement Rules

This includes: HPA, GBB full auto rifles, machine pistols and all electric weapons.

Pistol & Shotguns

Max 360 fps or 1.2 Joules. Max permitted BB weight 0.32g.

No Minimum Engagement Rules

This includes: Semi-Automatic or Fully Automatic pistols, can be gas powered, co2, spring or electric.

Single Shot Sniper Rifles

Max 500 fps or 2.32 Joules

Minimum Engagement Distance: 35 Metres

This includes: Any Spring or Gas powered Sniper Rifle, however any weapon used as a sniper rifle must only be able to fire a single shot through bolt action—this does not include AEGs put on single shot.

DMR (Designated Marksman Rifle)

Max 450 fps or 1.88 Joules

Minimum Engagement Distance: 25 Metres

Must have a real steel equivalent, Outer barrel length to be comparable to an M16 (508mm outer barrel length) and must be permanently locked off onto single shot. FULL AUTO is not allowed under any circumstances. No trigger Spamming. Magazine capacity not to be in excess of 150 rounds. Weapon system should be fitted with a scope with magnification.

Rapid Fire Support Weapons

Max 360 fps or 1.2 Joules. Max permitted BB weight 0.32g.

Minimum Engagement Distance: 25 Metres

- Due to UK law any airsoft weapon over these set limits will not be allowed to be used at all on our site at any time.
- Only 6mm plastic BB's are allowed to be used.
- All measurements/calculations are based on 0.2g BB's.
- All weapons being used on the day must be chronographed prior to being used in the gamezone.

- All weapons must be tagged with the colour in use on that day.
- If you make any adjustments at all to your weapon or change BB weight during the day, you will need to be re-chronoed.
- The staff reserve the right to weigh any players BB's in use.
- Random chronographing will take place throughout the day.
- Anyone found to deliberately breaking the rules may lead to an exclusion from the site.
- The Marshalls decision is final.
